siah Jesus with-reference-to the Gentiles, working-as-  
priest of the good-news of-the God, in-order-that the

Romans 15 KJ

15 Nevertheless, brethren, I have  
 written the more boldly unto you in

24 The one on-the-other-hand because-of his to-be-re-  
 maining with-reference-to the age he-is-having the  
priestly-office inviolable.



When this passage is  
 translated more accurately  
 it likens Paul to a priest in  
the temple; and the "good-news" the  
 light of the lampstand. (See also Heb.8:2)  
 Paul wrote by the Holy Spirit to the  
 "church" at Rome (1), Corinth (2), Galatia (3),  
Ephesus (4), Philippi (5), Colossae (6), and  
Thessalonica (7); exactly the 7 branches  
 of the lampstand.  
 See also the "control word" for "public-  
 minister", λειτουργός (leitourgos), it is  
 quite different from διάκονος, (diakonos).

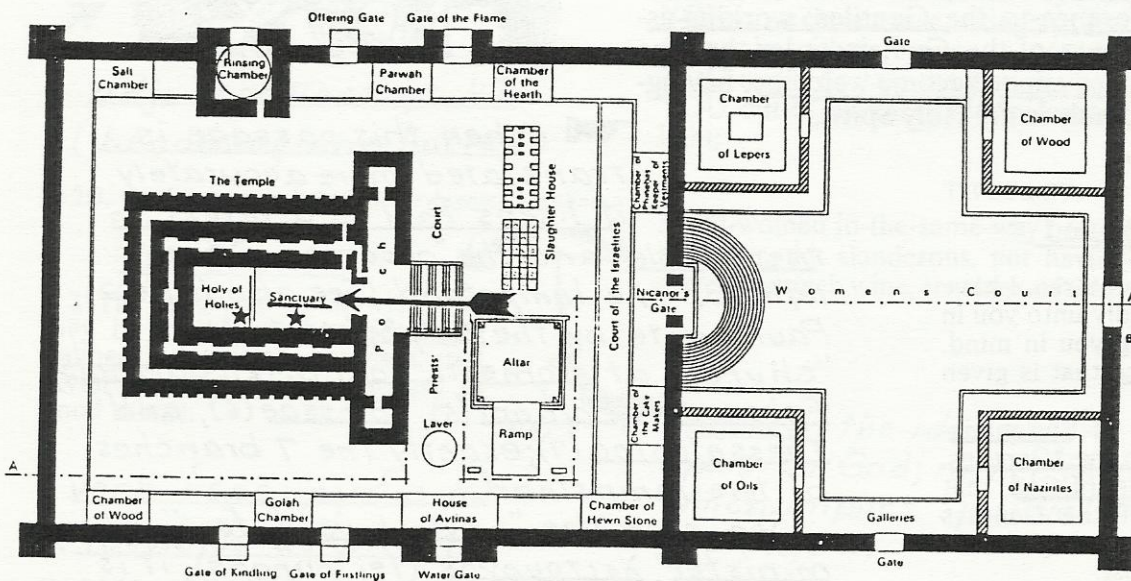

The KJ translates ἱερός (*hieros*),  
 "temple" 71x and ναός (*naos*),  
 "temple" 45x thus the subject

is totally confused. The word ναός (*naos*) should be "sanctuary",  
 that is, The Holy Place and The Holy of Holies. See "control-word," ναός.
