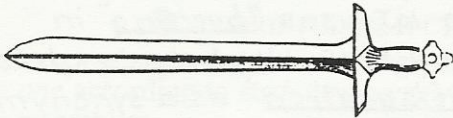


ρομφαία - p.1File under: ρομφαία or romphaia
English: "sword"ρομφαία κ.Ι

- Lu. 2:35. Yea, a sword shall pierce through
 Rev. 1:16, a sharp twoedged sword :
 2:12, which hath the sharp sword.
 16, with the sword of my mouth.
 6: 8, to kill with sword,
 19:15, out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword,
 21, slain with the sword of him that sat



This word is used 7x and always in an allegory. This word must not be confused with the word μάχαρα, or (machaira), dagger.

This sword was a large offensive weapon, indicative of war.
 Note just 2 uses in the Septuagint.

Genesis 3

24 So ^ahe drove out the man; and he placed ^bat the east of the garden of Eden ^cCher'-u-bim, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of ^dlife.

Isaiah 66

16 For by fire and by ^ahis sword will the LORD plead with all flesh: and the slain of the LORD shall be ^bmany.

In use #4 note:
ἐν τῇ ρομφαίᾳ τοῦ
 "in (or with) the sword
στόματός μου.
 of-the mouth of-me."

In use #4 the war is with the "assembly"; in uses #6, #7 with Gentiles, in use #5 general war.

LUKE 2 CT #1

34 And Simeon blessed them, and said to Mary his mother, Behold this-one is-lying with-reference-to a falling and a standing-again of-many among the Israeli, and with-reference-to a sign being-contradicted;
 35 But a sword will-go-through also of-your soul itself; in-which-case deliberations out-of many hearts might-be-uncovered.

REVELATION 1 CT #2

13 And in the midst of-the lampstands one like a son of-MAN, having-been-and-still-clothed-in to-the-feet and having-been-and-still-girded-around at the breasts with a belt [girdle] made-of-gold;
 14 But his head and the hairs white as wool, white as snow, and his eyes as a flame of-fire.
 15 And his feet like to-chalcolibanus as having-been-and-still-on-fire from in a furnace, and his voice as a noise [voice] of-many waters.
 16 And holding in his right hand seven stars, and out-of his mouth a sharp two-edged sword proceeding-out, and his countenance as the sun appearing in its power.

REVELATION 2 CT #3, #4

12 And to-the messenger of-the assembly in Pergamum you-write: These-things-here the one having the sword, namely-the two-edged, namely-the sharp is-saying:
 16 You-repent therefore; but if not, I-am-coming to-you speedily and I-shall-war with them in the sword of my mouth.

REVELATION 6 CT #5

8 And I-saw, and behold a green horse, and the one sitting above-upon it, name to-him was the death, and the hades was-following with him, and authority was-given to-them upon the fourth-of-the earth, to-kill with sword and with famine and with death even by the beasts-of-the earth.

REVELATION 19 CT #6, #7

15 And out-of his mouth a sharp sword is-proceeding-out, in-order-that with it he-might-smite the Gentiles; and he himself will-shepherd them with a rod of-iron; and he himself is-treading the wine-press of-the wine, namely-of-the anger, and of-the wrath of-the God namely-the Almighty.

21 And the others were-killed with the sword of-the one sitting on the horse namely-the sword proceeding-out, out-of his mouth, and all the birds-of-prey were-satisfied out-of their flesh.
